**Chapter - 1 The Sentence**

1. What is sentence?

Ans. A sentence is a group of words in an order that makes sense.

E. g. - The girls are dancing.

**Chapter - 2 Statements and Questions**

1. What is statement or an assertive sentence?

Ans. A sentence that simply tells something is called a statement or an assertive sentence.

E. g. - Monika has two brothers.

2. What is called a question or an interrogative sentence?

Ans. A sentence that asks something is called a question or an interrogative sentence.

E. g. - Where did you buy the mangoes from?

**Chapter - 4 Naming Words**

1. What is naming words?

Ans. Naming words are used to name persons, places, animals or things.

E. g. - Lion, Door, Sea, Mukesh etc.

**Chapter - 5 Common and Specific Names**

1. What is common name?

Ans. Some naming words indicate common names of people, places or things.

E. g. - Dog, City, Sister etc.

2. What is specific name?

Ans. It refers to the names of a particular people, animal, bird, insect, place or thing.

E. g. - Rover, Christmas, Monday etc.

**Chapter - 8 Describing Words**

1. What is describing words?

Ans. Describing words describe persons, animals, birds, places or things.

E. g. - big, blue, round, hot etc.
